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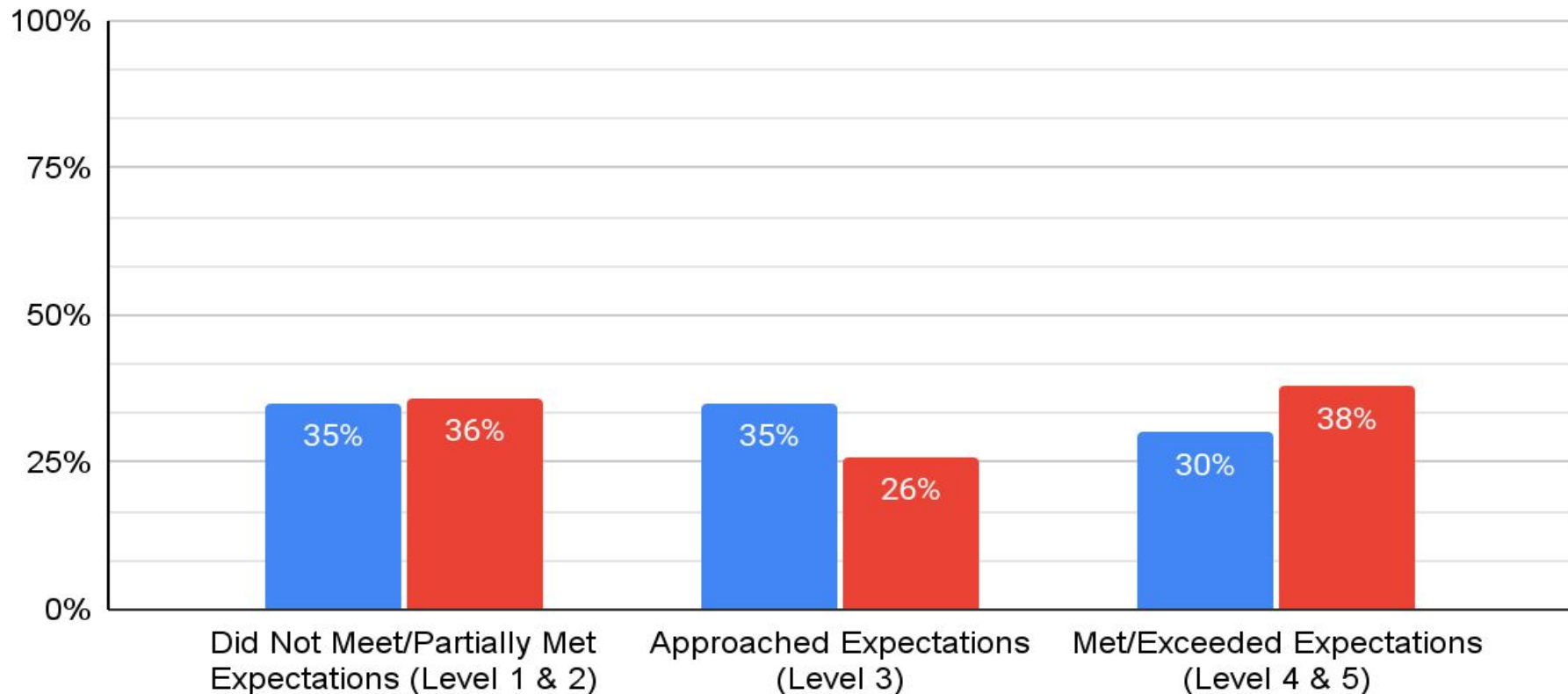


What is NJSLA?

- New Jersey Student Learning Assessments are statewide assessments that assess students' progress toward the New Jersey Learning Standards in English Language Arts (ELA), Mathematics, and Science.
- Typically administered in computer-based format.
- ELA Assessments focus on writing effectively when analyzing texts.
- Mathematics Assessments focus on applying skills and concepts and understanding multi-step problems that require abstract reasoning and modeling real-world problems, precision, perseverance, and strategic use of tools.
- Science Assessments (Gr. 5 only) focus on applying scientific concepts and practices within the domains of Earth & Space, life, and physical science
- Given in the spring of Grades 3-6.

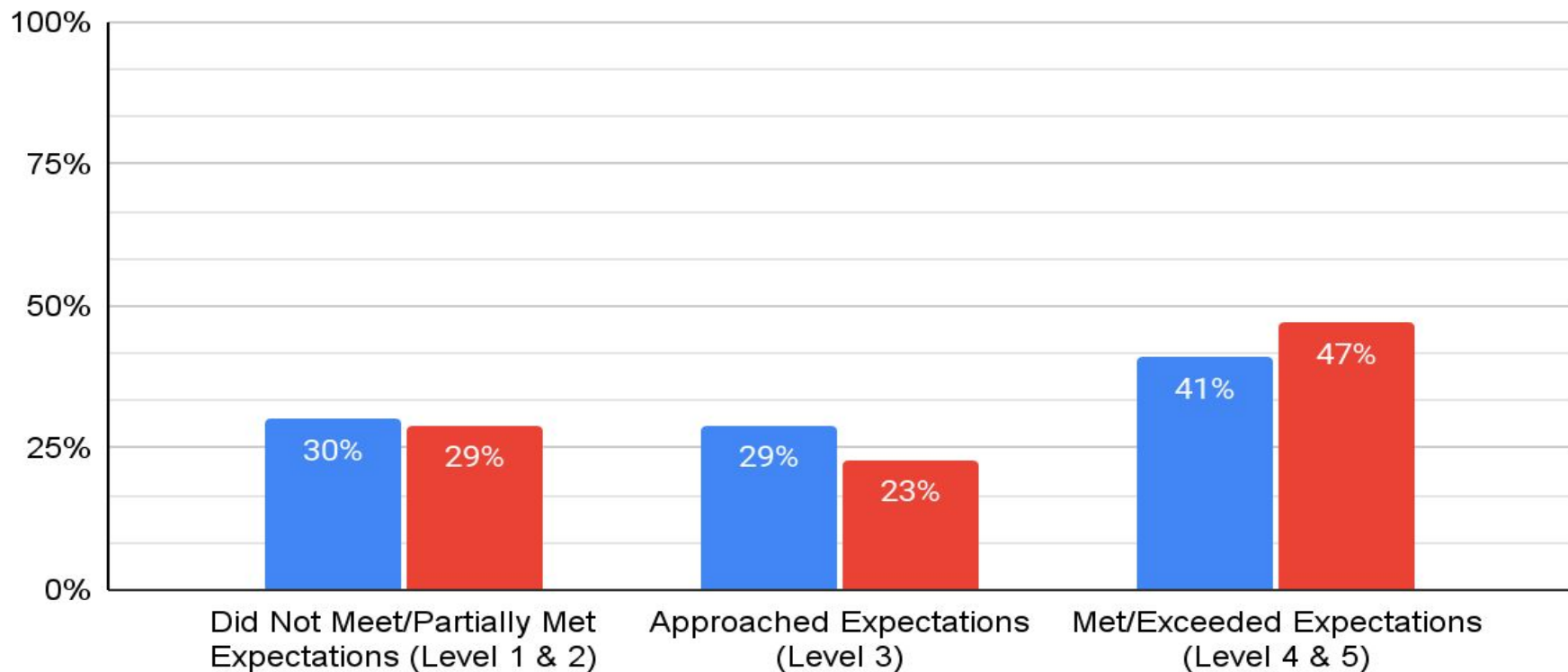
Grades 3-6 Math NJSLA Results 21-22

District State



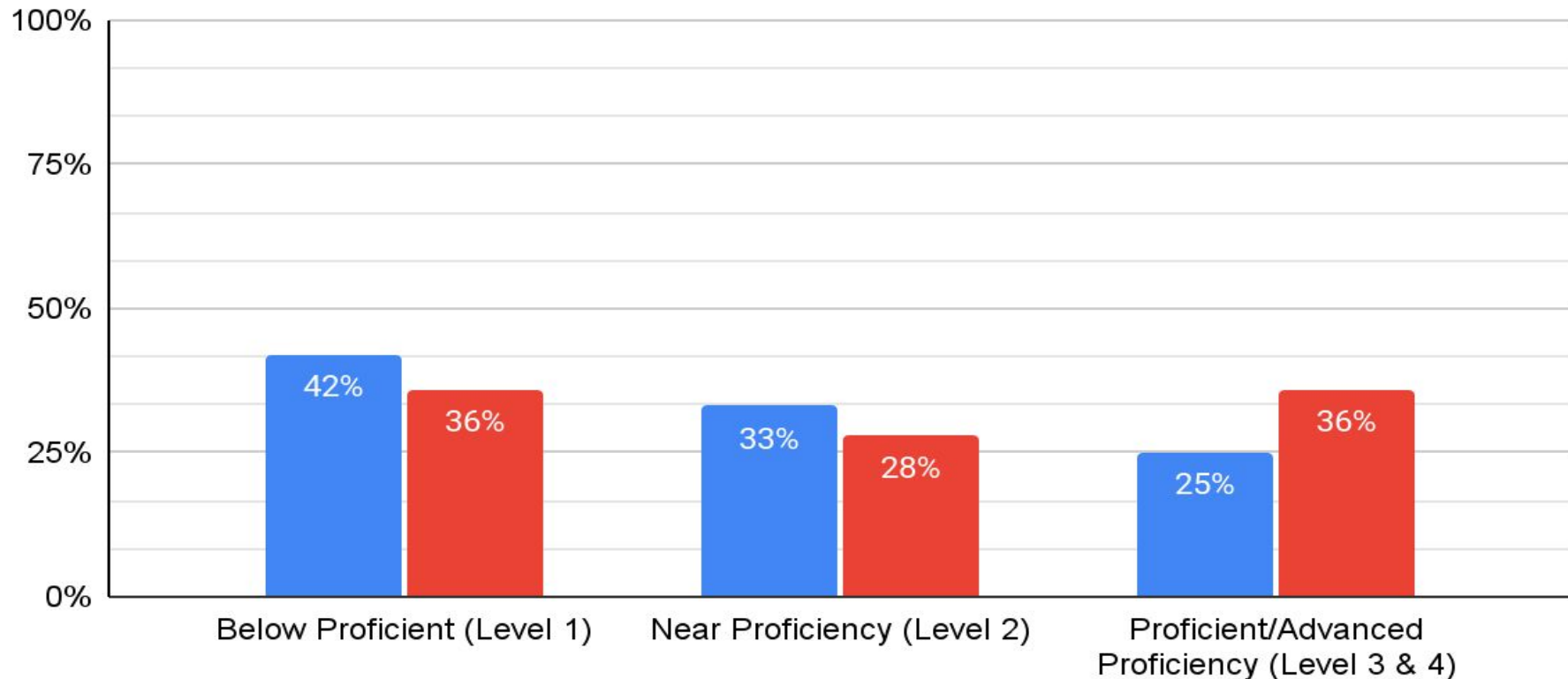
Grades 3-6 ELA NJSLA Results 21-22
